

PLEASE NOTE:

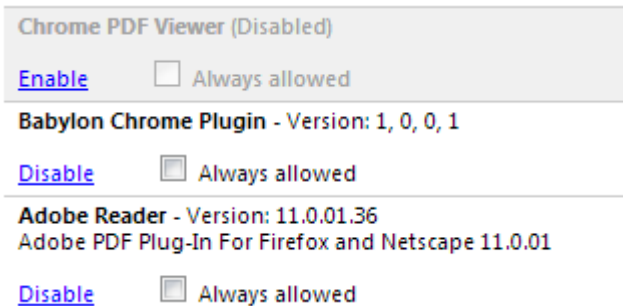
To fill out PDF forms, you'll need Adobe's plugins. Most computers come pre-loaded with reader, but if you don't have it, visit <http://get.adobe.com/reader/> to download it for free.

Internet Explorer will typically use Adobe by default, but other major browsers may not. Below are instructions on how to change the settings to use Adobe's plugins.

GOOGLE CHROME USERS:

PDF pages will be displayed, but fillable PDF forms including rental applications will not work correctly unless you have the Adobe Reader Plugin. You can use another browser such as Internet Explorer, or follow the steps below to enable Adobe's plugin.

- 1) Type chrome://plugins/ into the address bar at the top of your browser window.
- 2) Disable the Chrome PDF Viewer.
- 3) Enable the Adobe Reader Plugin.
- 4) It should look like this when you're done



- 5) Try to open the PDF you were looking for again. PDFs should now display correctly. If spaces on forms are highlighted, you will know that it worked.
